WATCH OUT FOR

-  People asking personal questions too fast
-  Pressure to meet in real life
-  Requests for photos, videos, or secrets
-  Someone telling you to keep chats private

BE INTERNET SMART

KEEP IT PRIVATE

No sharing your address, school, host family info, phone number, or live location.

CHECK PROFILES

Fake photos and stories are common.

TAKE YOUR TIME

Real friends don't rush or pressure you.

THINK BEFORE YOU SEND

Once it's sent, you can't take it back.

MEETING SOMEONE IN REAL LIFE?

Only if ALL of these are true:

- ✓ A trusted adult knows
- ✓ It's a public place
- ✓ You bring a friend
- ✗ Never go alone

NEED HELP? SAY SOMETHING.

You will NOT get in trouble.
