On our High School Imm

On our High School Immersion for Groups programme, overseas students attend a British or Irish public (state) school alongside local students.

Students are assigned a British / Irish student 'Buddy' who attends some classes with them and helps them adjust to life in their new school.

Our students follow the same academic curriculum as local students of their age.

Involvement in sports and arts may be compulsory, and participation in extracurricular activities will be encouraged.

British and Irish public schools are amongst the best government-funded schools in the world. All our partner schools:

- Have a low international student population.
- Have a high standard of teaching.
- Offer a broad range of academic subjects at all levels.
- Have a positive attitude towards hosting international students.

All school locations are safe, close to an international airport and have plenty to offer international students.

Flexible Options

This programme can be tailored to the needs of your group.

Programmes can be arranged on dates that suit your group, at any time during the academic year, except during school closures and exam periods.

Groups can choose a programme from 1 to 4 weeks long, and can add activities and excursions to their programme to get the most out of their stay.

Day by Day

Students will take themselves to and from school. Most of our host families live within walking distance from the school. For those who need to use public transport, this will be covered with the local travel card.

Programme timetable is for illustrative purposes only. Each student will have an individual programme of study. Subjects, timings and activities will vary.
